

A Picture of Health

All of us are concerned about how other people view us. Do others see us as healthy, well put together people? What does a healthy, well adjusted young man look like? How about a healthy, well adjusted young woman? An older woman? An older man? In our minds, we have an idea about how things “should be” at a given stage of life. God, however, does not see as man sees. Man looks at the outward appearance, but God looks on the heart. We should not be as concerned with what people see outwardly. We should be more concerned about what people perceive spiritually in us. Each of us is a spiritual portrait in progress. God’s Spirit is trying to make us more beautiful than we ever dreamed we could be. What spiritual picture do others see when they look at us?

In Titus 2, Paul paints a spiritual picture of godly people in different age groups. He paints a picture of an older man who is temperate and moderate in his behavior, a man whose character others respect, a man who is disciplined in his behavior and spiritually healthy, though his body may be declining. This man is vigorous in his faith, in his demonstrated Christian love toward others, and in his steadfast endurance in Christ.

Paul paints mature spiritual women as “holy in their conduct,” not gossiping and talking negatively about others, and not drunkards. He paints them “teachers of what is good.” They do this by their example of inner beauty, adorned with “a gentle and quiet spirit.” They quietly do good things for their family and others, and as they do these good things, they lovingly mentor the younger women, “training them” to be as God wants them to be.

Godly older women train the younger women to work at loving their husbands and children. They train them to model chaste and pure behavior, observing

proper boundaries around men. They train the younger women to pay attention to their own homes and families, to be disciplined, and make it obvious to everyone that they are devoted to their own husbands.

Paul paints young spiritual men as serious and disciplined in their lives. God’s young men are involved in “good works” and are sincere and careful in their teaching about God. These young men command respect because of their conduct and their speech, casting a favorable light on the Lord’s church.

above? The Holy Spirit is working on a portrait of each Christian. He “paints” us using at least three techniques. He paints spiritually healthy people by using “sound teaching” or “healthy teaching.” A steady diet of this teaching changes us for the better from the inside out. He paints us using “training in godliness” or “godly exercise”. This means that the more we practice doing God’s will in all aspects of life, the more we actually become like God. He also paints us using faith experiences. When we endure trials and keep trusting God, he colors us with humility and wisdom. Using “healthy teaching,” “godly exercise,” and “faith experiences” the Spirit of God seeks to make us as beautiful as we will allow him to make us. So, how is your spiritual portrait coming along? When others look at that portrait as it is today, what do they see? Lord, “Let the beauty of Jesus be seen in me!”
