“A Trustworthy Saying”

For whatever reasons, Timothy had become discouraged in his ministry in Ephesus. Evidently, as hard as he tried to teach people about Christ and Christianity, there were people present there who insisted on quarreling about meaningless issues and causing trouble for him. As a result of the conflict, Timothy had become defensive, timid, and somewhat passive in his ministry. He had a job to do, and Satan had discouraged him from moving ahead with it as he should. Paul wrote the second letter to Timothy to encourage him, to boost him into moving ahead assertively with the work of preaching the word.

Paul told his young protégé, “God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love, and of self-discipline.” Powerful Christians have their trust in God and are moving ahead with purpose and direction in their spiritual walk. They are assertively about the Father's business, disciplining themselves to advance, and not to retreat from their tasks. Timothy's human instincts told him to hide, to become passive, to take up a defensive posture and protect himself. Paul wanted a soldier of Christ who would press the battle forward.

How many of us are going about our Christianity, our Christian mission, our Christian duty, with the confident mindset of dedicated soldiers, or committed athletes, or dedicated farmers trying to make a crop, or skilled workmen with no reason to be ashamed. How many of us, like Timothy was tempted to do, are going about with an attitude of timidity, fear, shame, and insecurity instead of boldness, confidence, and commitment.

Paul urged Timothy not to let his gifts lie dormant and unused, but to “fan into flame” his gifts and use them to preach the word. He wanted Timothy out there teaching, reminding, warning, instructing, and encouraging people. He wanted Timothy to be a real workman who needn't be ashamed, handling correctly the word that had been entrusted to him. He assured Timothy that moving forward would not be easy. He must be prepared to endure hardship in order to accomplish his task.

Having said all of this, Paul quoted Timothy the words of an ancient hymn to remind him of

his commitments to Christ and the basic spiritual realities. "If we died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we deny him, he will also deny us. If we are faithless, he remains faithful, for he cannot deny himself." These basic truths spurred Timothy onward, helping him move out of his timidity and passivity and move ahead assertively with God's work. May those truths spur each of us onward to advance into the good fight and not to retreat from it.
