“Deal or No Deal?”

June 6, 2010

In the popular game show, contestants are presented with a financial incentive to give up their quest for the money they might discover in a certain briefcase. The host presents the offer and asks, "Deal or No Deal?" Since the beginning of time, God has been pursuing human beings, trying to establish relationships with them. God presents his offer to people, hoping that they will accept it and enter into a relationship with Him. God presents the offer and leaves it up to each of us to decide. Will it be "Deal or No Deal?"

God offered a deal to Noah. He told Noah of the destruction to come and offered him safety if he would build a huge boat and enter it along with the various species of animals on earth. Noah took the deal. He did what God asked and God did what God said he would do.

God demonstrated his faithfulness by keeping his promises to Noah, and to Abraham. God promised to make Abraham into a great nation, to bless him, and to curse his enemies. God promised to give Abraham and his offspring the land of Canaan. God kept all of these promises in spite of many obstacles, demonstrating his faithfulness to his people.

God showed that he wanted to enter into a relationship with Abraham's children, the Israelites, when he sent Moses to Egypt and began the process of rescuing them from slavery. By sending the plagues, by breaking the will of the Egyptian oppressors, by destroying the Egyptian army, and by leading Israel through the Red Sea, God set them free and demonstrated his seriousness about establishing a relationship with them. At Sinai, God made Israel an offer. He gave them his law, and told them that if they would do what he asked, he would make them his special people and bless them richly. Based on his proven faithfulness and his generous offer, Israel said, "Deal."

As time went by, Israel reneged on their deal over and over. They turned their backs on God and his law repeatedly. God pleaded with them to return and honor their agreement, but they refused. Even when some wanted to serve God, many others turned away. So God said he was going to make a new deal with people who wanted to serve Him.

This new deal, said God, would be for people who would allow God to write his law in their minds. It would be for people who would make the effort to come to know God, for those who would willingly agree to be God's people. For those who truly wanted this relationship and were willing to honor it, God promised, "I will forgive their iniquities and remember their sins no more."

God showed he was serious by sending his Son, by making him suffer on the cross as a sacrifice for sins, and by raising him from the dead. After the resurrection, on the day of Pentecost in Jerusalem, God first offered the new deal to individual people. He told people that if they would accept Christ as Lord of their lives, turn to him in submission, and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins, he would give them his indwelling Spirit and enter a special relationship with each of them. Three thousand individuals said, "deal" and others said "no deal."

When each of us hears and understands the gospel, God is offering to enter a relationship with us. If we seriously want the relationship and are willing to commit actively to the relationship, we say, "deal" and we begin our life with God. We reaffirm our agreement with God as we continue to decide to maintain the relationship. Do you and God have a deal?

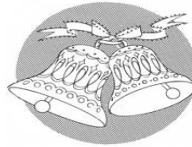
Attention Moms with Babies:
