"A Recipe for Faithfulness"

June 13, 2010

The book of Hebrews is an exhortation to people who were thinking of giving up their Christianity and turning their backs on Christ. Most of the book tells of all of the wonderful things God has prepared for those individuals who will accept a new covenant or a new relationship or a new deal with Him. Once we accept that personal deal with God, faithfulness involves our purposeful action in honoring our deal.

The first key ingredient in a recipe for faithfulness is conviction. We will not be faithful to something we don't believe. Those Christians who were absolutely convinced that Christ was God's perfect sacrifice for sins, that God had made Christ absolute ruler of his people, and that Christ was now our only high priest and mediator with God were much more likely to faithfully serve Christ. Those who did not believe these things had no reason to be faithful. How strong are your convictions? Are they strong enough to keep you faithful?

Next, we must act on our convictions about Christ and draw near to God through Him. We take our first decisive actions when we allow our hearts to be cleansed by his sinless blood as our bodies are washed in baptism. Then, we continue to act on our faith as we pray to God through Christ, as we seek a closer knowledge and appreciation of God in Scripture, as we sing praises to Him, as we offer our financial gifts to Him, and as we obediently serve to further His mission. Those who are actively drawing near to God are being faithful to their deal.

Next, add a strong dose of commitment. The book of Hebrews says, "Let us hold fast our confession." Holding fast describes a determination, a commitment, or a firm decision to persist. This commitment is based on trusting God's promises regarding his grace, his helpful presence in our lives, the return of Christ, and our reward in eternity. How firm is the commitment in your heart? It is a vital ingredient of

faithfulness.

Next, stir in your active encouragement of other people's faith. When we begin to work toward helping others remain faithful, we also help ourselves. We do this as we regularly gather with other Christians and regularly encourage them to be involved in good deeds and service to God. We do this when we regularly engage with others in prayer and praise and listening to the word as we strengthen one another's faith.

Finally, stir in a reminder about the alternative to faithfulness. The book of Hebrews makes it clear that the alternative to faithfulness is the willful sin of failing to honor your deal with God. God knows

we can never be perfect, but he expects us to be sincerely penitent and to keep on trying to honor our deal as long as we live. If we stop trying, and we renounce our deal, we have rejected our only sacrifice for sin. The only thing that remains is fiery judgment.

God has made a wonderful new covenant with each of us in Christ. To be faithful to this covenant, we must be deeply convicted. We must act on that conviction by constantly drawing near to God. We must be strongly committed because we trust in God's promises. We must busy ourselves in encouraging others to be faithful. We must remind ourselves often of the unacceptable alternative to faithfulness. This recipe for faithfulness really works. It is a tried and true old Christian recipe from the book of Hebrews.
