“Victory Over Satan”

The dragon, the ancient serpent, is at war with mankind. Since the fall of man, there has been a state of enmity between Satan and the forces of evil and the people who would do the will of God. Scripture promises us that ultimately, the victory will belong to the Lord. Meanwhile, we fight soul by soul, house by house, moment by moment with the Enemy of all.

There is victory over Satan each time someone obeys the gospel of Christ. At that moment, the battle is won and a soul is set free from Satan's grasp. God tells us that he is working when we are buried in baptism and raised from the water. We have allowed God's word to convict us, freeing our minds from Satan's lies, and we have submitted ourselves to God. He made us alive together with Christ, forgiving our sins, canceling our impossible debt, and pulling us free from Satan's grasp. A great victory is won each time a soul is united with Christ.

There is a victory won every time a soul is restored to faithfulness. Satan wants us back if we have been rescued by God. He never stops trying to regain what he has lost. When one falls into his traps and continues in willful sin, Satan reclaims that soul and breaks the tie between the saved person and God. When such an apostate soul turns back to God, another great victory is won.

There is victory over Satan each time a person refuses to be deceived. Satan lies to us constantly about where we came from, about what is important, about what is good and what is evil, and about the very meaning of life. When we hold fast to God's word, and allow it to continually convict us, we "bring every thought into captivity unto the obedience of Christ." Satan loses when people love the truth and refuse to believe his attractive lies.

There is victory over Satan each time a person resists temptation. Satan entices us and lures us

into disobedience. Satan finds us when we are weak and attacks at our weakest points. He tempts us with our own fears, our own desires, and our own weaknesses. When we refuse, like Jesus refused, a victory is won and Satan may withdraw from us until he finds us weak again.

There is victory over Satan when unity wins out over division in the church. Satan works to pit us against one another. He loves strife, not harmony. He loves competition, not cooperation. He loves division, when God loves peace. Paul told the Romans

to mark those who cause division and turn away from them. He said if they would do this, the God of peace would crush Satan under their feet. Satan is crushed when we refuse to allow Satan to divide us from our fellow saints.

There is victory over Satan each time a faithful Christian dies. Paul asked, "O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?" To the Christian, the one covered by the blood of Christ, there is no sting in death. "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord!" To us, the death of a saint is a great victory. A soul is forever free from Satan's tyranny.

The battle belongs to the Lord. Ultimately, Christ will conquer. Satan will be cast into the lake of fire where he will be tormented day and night forever and ever. Remember, Christian, there is a fierce war going on. Satan has great wrath because he knows his time is short. He is at war with those who keep the commandments of God and hold the testimony of Jesus. Keep your trust in God and his word! Keep your eyes and ears open! Take advantage of every victory over our Enemy!
