## *“Powerful Relationships”*

May 9, 2010

Relationships are the context in which people have influence over other people. Parental relationships and spousal relationships are the most powerful because they are the most lasting and most intimate. Consider today the powerful relationships that characterize the lives of Christian women. Women truly have the power to shape generations of people. Because children and husbands are so dependent on mothers and wives, the influence wielded by women in these relationships gives them great power. In fact, they have several kinds of power.

Women have the power of formation. As they talk to their children, love their children, and interact with their children they form the child's view of the world. Their conversations explain the world and its meaning. They tell their children about how God made them and all the things around them. They explain what is right and wrong, good and evil, and they form expectations along those lines. Through a variety of explanations and instructions, they shape and form the thinking of their children.

Women have the power of affirmation. As children do what is good and proper and pleasing, mothers affirm that behavior with smiles and hugs and praise. Women do the very same with their husbands when they praise them and love them and express appreciation for good things, honorable things, helpful things, and unselfish things. Through affirmation, godly women help to establish good patterns of behavior in both children and husbands.

Women have the power of correction. Because there is a loving relationship, when a child misbehaves, a mother can correct, demonstrate her displeasure at the behavior, and explain again what should be done. Because the relationship is so important to the child, the child is eager to correct the misbehavior so things are right again with the mother. When women show disappointment in the right way toward husbands who misbehave, they also have the

power of correction in the lives of men.

Women have the power of demonstration. Women show their children what it means to tell the truth, to be kind, to show appropriate affection, to serve others, to clean and care for possessions, and how to act toward a husband. They demonstrate forgiveness and correction and prayer and love for God's word and all kinds of things that will be burned into a child's memory forever. Demonstration is perhaps the most powerful tool a woman has, because what a child sees and experiences will outlast what one hears on any given occasion. Peter told women that they could even win unbelieving husbands to Christ by continually demonstrating godly behavior in their

When godly women talk about their vision for their own lives, and what they envision for their children and their husbands, they help the people in their family set goals for themselves. When these visions are visions of godliness, spiritual service, evangelistic influence, and spiritual growth, these things help children and godly husbands see their future in terms of all that God wants for them.  
The relationships of godly women are powerful platforms for doing good. When godly women use their power of formation, affirmation, correction, demonstration, and vision casting as God designed, they truly plant the seeds of divine work in the lives of all who love them.
