"Pursuing God"

May 30, 2010

Paul's encounter with the pagan philosophers in Athens is a reflection of Christianity's encounter with the world. The world does not know God. They are "without hope and without God." We have a message that is vital for their salvation.

Paul noticed that the Athenians were very religious people. The city was filled with objects of worship. They were concerned about spiritual things. Many people in our world who don't know the true God are very religious people. They are trying to find and understand spiritual things. They are seeking something greater than themselves.

Paul found an altar "To an unknown god." Using that as a basis, he told the people he wanted to tell them about the one they worshiped in ignorance. The world does not know the true God and cannot worship him properly because of that ignorance. People must know who God is, what he loves, what he hates, and what he has commanded in order to worship him acceptably and find a relationship with him.

Paul proclaimed the true God to the Athenians. Like the people of our day, they needed to know what God has revealed to man about himself. Paul told them the true God was the creator of all things. He told them that God rules over all things in the world, including people. He told them that God cannot be contained in any temple or location and that he does not need anything man can provide. Instead, Paul told them that God is the great Giver, the great Provider, of all things, including the very air we breathe. Paul told them that God is our Creator and we are created in his image. Everyone in the world needs to under-

stand these things and live accordingly.

Next, Paul told the Athenians why man was created. People all over the world are searching for the answer to the question, "Why am I here?" Paul explained that man was created to seek and find God. Our very reason for existence is to find a relationship with God and maintain that relationship. Human beings only find their fulfillment in serving God.

Finally, Paul revealed to the Athenians that God calls all people to repent of their paganism

and their ignorant worship, and to turn to the true God. As he told the Thessalonians, they "turned to God from idols, to serve the living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven." Paul explained that God has supplied the proof of the resurrection to lead all people to Jesus.

No human being can come to God except through Jesus Christ. The world is lost because they do not know God and are separated from God by sin. With the rest of God's people, we must bring the message of Christ to the world. "Christ for the world we sing. The world to Christ we bring!" May each of us find our niche as we contribute to the success of that eternal mission.

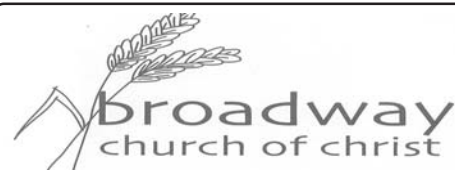
