

Getting teenagers connected with other Christians is done through small group activities that focus on acceptance. We get together for dinner, have Bible studies on Sunday nights in our member's homes, and spend time with them demonstrating basic Bible fundamentals such as God's love, grace, and prayer. This also gives us the opportunity to answer any questions they might have. This is a fundamental building block to growing one's own faith and for teenagers this is exceptionally important. Our youth ministry offers Bible classes that emphasize the plan of salvation and other basic principles of Christ's church. We go on retreats that allow for spiritual growth and renewal by relaxing and focusing on time with God through Bible study and prayer. Our teenagers attend big youth events all over the southeast like RENEWAL (Lynchburg, TN), Winterfest (Gatlinburg, TN), Uplift (Searcy, AR), Western KY Youth Camp (Marion, KY), and Celebration (Land Between the Lakes) to fellowship with other Christian teenagers. Our Bible curriculum also includes teaching our teens how to develop and keep spiritual habits of prayer, accountability, Bible memorization, involvement, giving, and studying God's word. We also encourage our teens to find and use the gifts with which God has blessed them.
