Signs & Miracles

Throughout the Old and New Testaments we have varying events that “proved God.” I think of the story in Judges 6 about Gideon and his fleece. As we move into the New Testament there are miracles and signs, both designed for a purpose but both different in presentation. Miracles exhibit God’s power and the transmission of God’s power to specific people. Many of Jesus’ healings were miracles. These had a great purpose in proving the power and the authority that Christ had. Many people followed Christ and glorified God after seeing these miracles (Matthew 9:8; 15:3). In his gospel account, John records specific miraculous workings performed by Christ to teach a spiritual lesson. The first one we see occurs at the wedding at Cana (John 2); where Jesus turns water into wine (2:8). The spiritual lesson is taught by the good wine that has been kept “until now.” Jesus is the “good wine” now being revealed. An example that may be easier to see is the familiar account of Jesus feeding the 5,000 (John 6:1-14). The miraculous working is that Jesus fed 5,000 people with with a boys lunch of 5 loaves and 2 fish. We read the purpose of this action later in chapter 6 when Christ proclaims that he performed this miraculous work, so these people may believe in Christ, whom God sent (6:29). Jesus then gives the spiritual application, that Jesus is the true Bread. The Bread that is better. The Bread that comes down from heaven. The Bread that if you eat of it you will never hunger.

Reflection:

When we read about Jesus as the bread of Life or the Light of the world after He healed the blind man do we believe in Jesus? When we read about Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead and after hearing Jesus proclaim the “he is the resurrection and the life,” do we believe in Jesus? The signs in John’s Gospel should create a true belief in Jesus as they did to those who witnessed them in person (John 20:30,21).


